#### Japan GGP hand over of Students' Dormitory for Montfort Technical Institute

The Government of Japan and the Montfort Technical Institute celebrated the completion of a student's dormitory building, funded through Japan's Grant Assistance for Grass-Roots Human Security Projects, GGP on Saturday, 8 September, 2018.

"It is my delight that we have completed this project, which will help increase employment opportunities for young people from the outer islands."

Brother Curzmecias Sebastian, Principal of Montfort thanked the people and the Government of Japan for their assistance. The new student's dormitory will be the first one for Montfort since it was established in 1996 and will be named after the first Principal who passed away early this year as Bro. Joseph Kottoor Memorial Boys Hostel.
