Japan GGP handover of a Classroom Building for Havelu/Tofoa GPS

The Government of Japan and the Government Primary School of Havelu/Tofoa celebrated the completion of their new classroom building, funded through Japan's Grant Assistance for Grass-Roots Human Security Projects (GGP) on Tuesday afternoon, 17 October 2017.
