District Soroban Competition 2021 – Successful

The district soroban competitions for Vava'u primary schools was successfully concluded last week on Thursday, 17 June at Fakamelino Hall, Neiafu.

The annual district competitions being held each for the outer islands of Ha'apai, Vava'u, 'Eua, the three districts for Tongatapu since 2010, were also held for the Niuatoputapu islands last year, and the Niuafu'ou this year.
