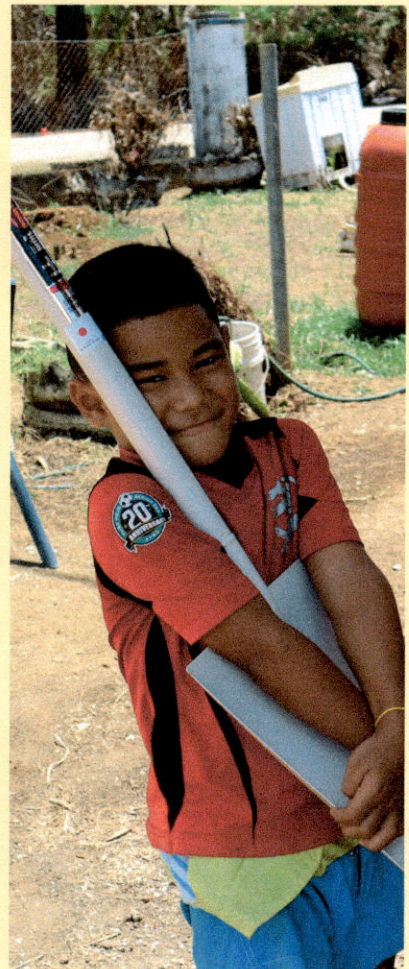
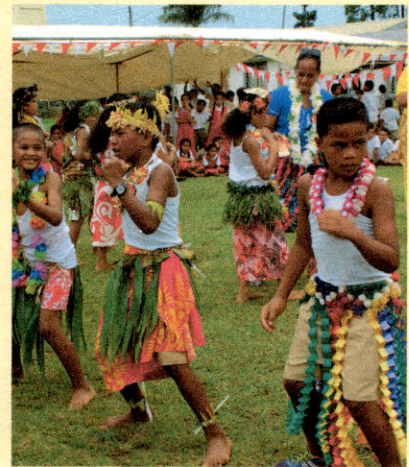

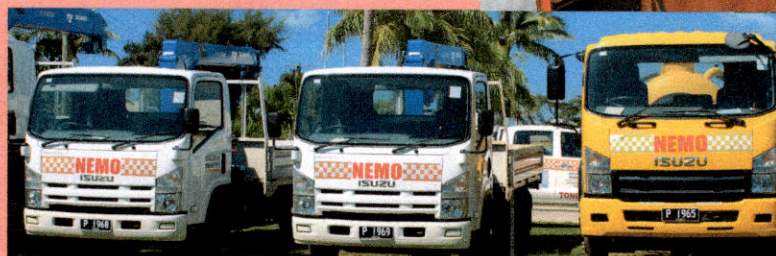


## Non-Project Grant Aid (NPGA)

NPGA is to support Tonga by promoting its economic and social development efforts through providing high quality made-in-Japan equipment

### Provision of Disaster Risk Reduction Equipment

- Grant: 300M Yen  
(6M Pa'anga)
- Handover :2017-2019  
To NEMO, MOH, TBC



### Provision of Medical Equipment



- Grant: 150M Yen  
(3M Pa'anga)
- Handover:  
To MOH in May 2021

# General Grant Aid

This assistance is to develop critical infrastructures for promoting, stability and prosperity in Tonga.



## Upgrading of Wharf for Domestic Transport

Grant: 3.3B Yen (66M pa'anga)  
Handover: June 2018

His Majesty King Tupou VI named the wharf "Taufa'ahau Tupou VI Domestic Wharf" in the grand opening ceremony.

## The Wind Power Project

Grant: 2.1B Yen (42M Pa'anga)  
Handover: July 2019

This wind power plant is greatly contributing to decrease the cost of Tonga's diesel fuel import by 1.5 million pa'anga per year

His Majesty named the wind power plant "li o Manumataongo (Fan of Manumataongo)



## Nationwide Early Warning System (NEWS) and Strengthening Disaster Communications

Grant: 2.8B Yen (56M pa'anga)  
Ongoing Project

An additional grant of 20M Yen (4.0M pa'anga) was approved in April 2021 for COVID-19 response.

After the completion, the time for alert transmission will be cut dramatically (eg. from 90mins to 8 mins)

## Japan Air Self-Defense Force C-130

## Japan Maritime Self-Defense Force "OHSUMI"

- Mission of "OHSUMI" and CH-47;
  - 1/24 Dispatched from Japan
  - 2/9 Arrived at the Vuna Wharf  
Unloaded the emergency supplies
  - 2/11 Supplied 40t drinking water to Tongatapu
  - 2/12 Supplied 110t drinking water to Tongatapu
  - 2/14 Delivered 9.6t drinking water to 'Eua
  - 2/15 Delivered 9.6t drinking water to Ha'apai
  - 2/16 Delivered 9.6t drinking water to Vava'u
