Japan's GGP Handover for Pangaimotu Kindergarten

The Embassy of Japan and the Pangaimotu Kindergarten, in Vava'u island celebrated the completion of a new classroom building, funded through Japan's Grant Assistance for Grass Roots Human Security Project (GGP) on Wednesday, 24 April 2024.

His Excellency Mr. INAGAKI Hisao Ambassador of Japan to the Kingdom of Tonga visited Vava'u islands and handed over the new building during a ceremony, attended by Dr. Mo'ale 'Otunuku, People's Representative for Vava'u 14. Other guests included Mr. Sione Tokoma'ata, Officer in Charge of Vava'u Primary Schools, Members of the Parents, Teachers Association and the students of the Government Primary School of Pangaimotu.

The occasion marks the first official event for Ambassador INAGAKI after his presentation of Credentials to His Majesty King Tupou VI, last week.

"I greatly appreciate the efforts and dedication of the Parents and Teachers Association to complete this project. I believe that education is the foundation for a bright future for everyone. It is our social responsibility to provide a quality education for children of all ages," said Ambassador INAGAKI
